Business Arising from Previous minutes.

- **CPV Review and Board update:** The focus for the new Board will be strategic planning and Regional forums will be set-up to progress local operational issues.
- **Wills Terrace and Anzac Hill, Alice Springs Town Council** –Council is looking to change their procedures in relation to street signage.
- **CPV Driver Training** – Training package has been sent to Department of Education and Training for approval.
- Stats have been received in relation to current holders of provisional CPV ID cards. Around 90 people may be eligible for the RPL training process.
- A letter has been drafted to the Minister requesting consideration for a 'Remote Area Training Allowance' for current eligible Provisional Card Holders employed in the Alice Springs CPV Industry.
- **PH Vacant signage** - Six month PH Vacant sign trial is ongoing and DLP has requested feedback from the committee in relation to the success of the trial.
